NOTE

WHEN TO FILE:

Initially, each local officer/employee, sta officer, and specified state employee mu file within 30 days of the date of his or h appointment or of the beginning of emplo ment. Appointees who must be confirmed the Senate must file prior to confirmation, ever if that is less than 30 days from the date of the appointment.

Candidates for publicly-elected local office must file at the same time they file the qualifying papers.

Thereafter, local officers/employees, starefficers, and specified state employees a required to file by July 1st following ear calendar year in which they hold their potions.

Finally, at the end of office or employment each local officer/employee, state officer, as specified state employee is required to file final disclosure form (Form 1F) within 60 day of leaving office or employment.
