

If you were mailed the form by the Commission on Ethics or a County Supervisor of Elections for your annual disclosure filing, return the form to that location. To determine what category your position falls under, see page 3 of instructions.

Local officers/employees file with the Supervisor of Elections of the county in which they permanently reside. MULTIPLE FILING UNNECESSARY: A candidate who files a Form 1 with a qualifying officer is not required to file with the Commission or Supervisor of Elections.

WHEN TO FILE: Initially, each local officer/employee, state officer, and specified state employee must file **within 30 days** of the date of his or her appointment or of the beginning of employment. Appointees who must be confirmed by the Senate must file prior to confirmation, even if that is less than 30 days from the date of their appointment.

Candidates must file at the same time they file their qualifying papers.

Thereafter, file by July 1 following each calendar year in which they hold their positions.

Finally, file a final disclosure form (Form 1F) within 60 days of leaving office or employment. Filing a CE Form 1F (Final Statement of Financial Interests) does not relieve the filer of filing a CE Form 1 if the filer was in his or her position on December 31, 2022.

**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION TO FILE 2022 CE FORM 1
FOR GOOD CAUSE**

The above-referenced individual is required to file a 2022 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. That disclosure was due on July 3, 2023, with a grace period until September 1, 2023. However, Section 112.3151, Florida Statutes, provides that the Commission chair may, for good cause, on an individual basis, extend the filing deadline for submission of any disclosures under the provisions of Part III, Chapter 112, Florida Statutes, or Article II, Section 8, Florida Constitution, by 45 days.

On August 29, 2023, Governor DeSantis issued Executive Order 23-175, in which he declared 49 counties to be under a state of emergency due to the threat posed by Hurricane Idalia. The above-referenced individual resides in one of the counties that was included in the state of emergency, which situation prevented him or her from submitting his or her disclosure.

Therefore, the above-referenced individual is **HEREBY GRANTED** an extension of 45 days to file his or her 2022 CE Form 1. The above-referenced individual must file his or her 2022 CE Form 1 **by October 16, 2023**. Pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes, failure to file by October 16, 2023, will result in an assessed fine of \$25 per day late, up to a maximum of \$1,500. Commission staff are available to answer any questions about the 2022 CE Form 1.
