	FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics, meeting in public session on March 13, 2003, on the timely appeal of Marvin Mulkey pursuant to Section 112.3145(6)(f), Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated due date. There are no material facts in dispute. Appellant did not request a hearing before the Commission.

Findings of Fact

- 1. During the year 2001, Marvin Mulkey served as a member of the Page Park Local Neighborhood District Committee. He was late filing a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, for the year 2001.
- 2. In 2002, the designated due date for 2001 CE Form 1 annual filings was September 3, 2002, and Appellant's CE Form 1 was filed on April 17, 2003, (more than 60 days late), resulting in an automatic fine of \$1500.

3. Appellant states in this appeal that in 2001, he was mugged and beaten with a hammer on his head and face, breaking his jaw in seven places. He notes that the physical and emotional damage is irreversible. He is 82 years old.

Conclusions of Law

- 4. The Commission has jurisdiction over Appellant and over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.
- 5. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government. In order to increase compliance, beginning in 2001 the Legislature provided for an automatic fine of \$25 per day, up to a cap of \$1,500, on persons who do not timely file their financial disclosure statements. Under the law, the Legislature permitted the Commission to waive a fine only "based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date"
 - 6. Rule 34-8.215, Florida Administrative Code, defines "unusual circumstances" as uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the reporting individual has no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirement. Circumstances which allow for time in which to take those steps necessary to assure compliance with the filing requirement shall be deemed not to constitute unusual circumstances.
- 7. Based on the representations of Appellant in this appeal, that he had been brutally attacked in the previous year, sustaining serious injury, the Commission finds that he has demonstrated that the delay in filing his CE Form 1 for 2001 resulted from "unusual circumstances" as defined above.

Order

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby waives the -assessed fine of \$1500, provided that Appellant files his/her CE Form 1, 2001.
