Thank you for serving as a member of the Airports Special Management Committee (ASMC). Since you have resigned from the ASMC, you will need to file a Form 1F - Final Statement of Financial Interests, per Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes, within 60 days. There is an exception to this rule if you take another public position that requires financial disclosure within the 60 days, or you already file disclosure by virtue of your service on another public board. Unless the exception applies, you would be required to file Form 1F within 60 days of November 9, 2010, for the calendar year 2010.
